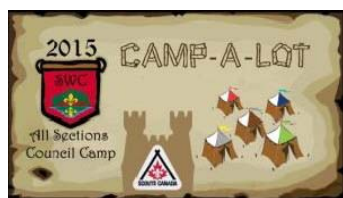
► Registration 2015-16 Scouting Year
